

Pauline Black Wolf

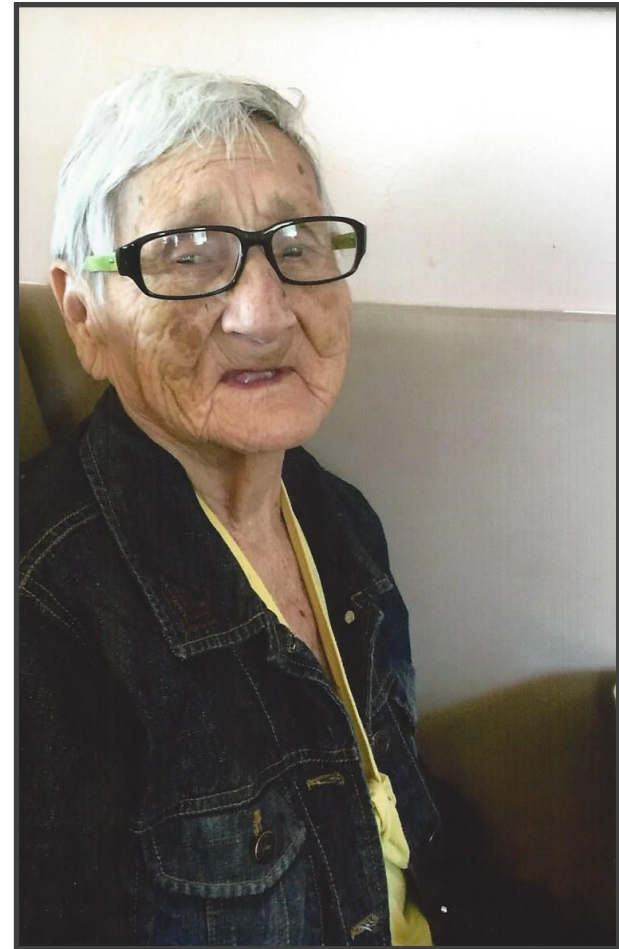
