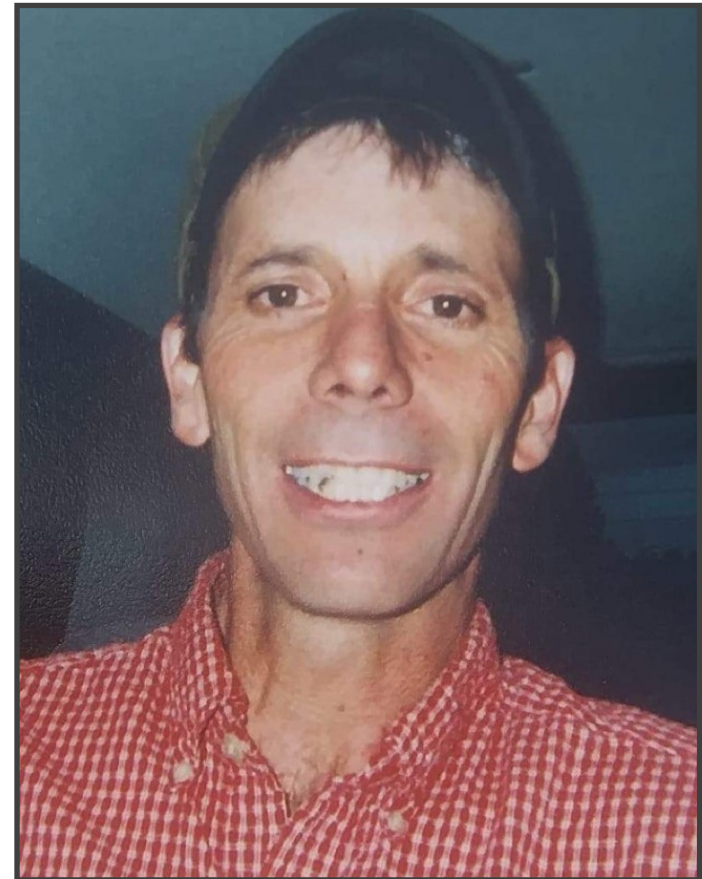


Brad Hunger
